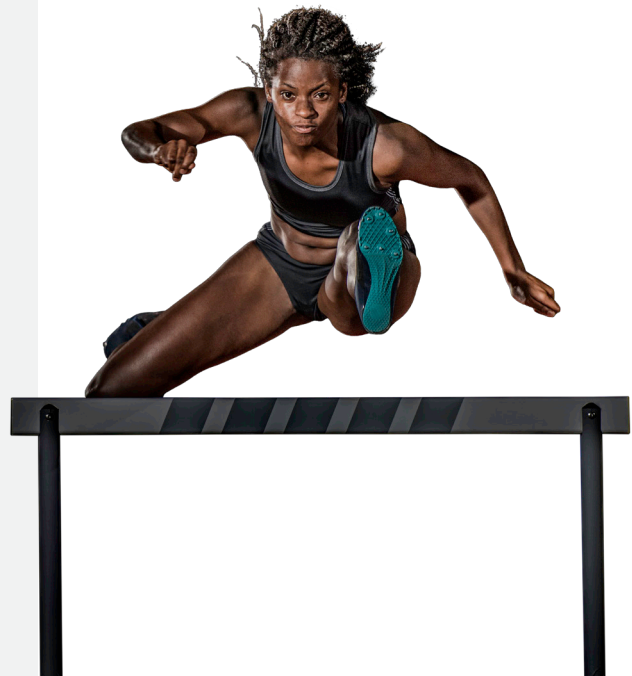
#### Raising Awareness

<sup>1</sup>The federal Protecting Young Victims from Sexual Abuse and Safe Sport Authorization Act of 2017 codifies the Center's authority and mandate to independently respond to and resolve sexual, emotional, and physical misconduct reports in the U.S. Olympic and Paralympic Movement. The Center establishes and enforces policies across the Movement, encompassing the U.S. Olympic & Paralympic Committee and 50+ affiliated National Governing Bodies (NGBs), and regularly audits these organizations to ensure compliance.

The U.S. Center for SafeSport was created to address and prevent abuse and misconduct in the Olympic and Paralympic Movement, from which it is independent. Our mission extends to support abuse prevention and awareness across the United States.
